Liveable Neighbourhoods Funding Bid

Newham Council is going to submit a funding bid to Transport for London (TfL) in November to deliver a Liveable Neighbourhoods scheme in the Freemasons Road area (see map overleaf).

TfL's Liveable Neighbourhoods programme gives boroughs the opportunity to bid for funding between £1m and 10m for projects that encourage walking, cycling and the use of public transport. The project should also deliver attractive and healthy neighbourhoods for residents and businesses in the area whilst improving air quality.

The bid is currently in the early stages of development. We want to find out what kind of improvements are important to you and include these in our bid.

TfL will let us know if our bid is successful in February 2019. If we are successful, and depending on the amount of funding received, we will then develop the scheme in conjunction with residents and consult formally before implementation.
